

Theo Henrar



Theo Henrar was appointed President of FME by the FME members' meeting on 17 June 2021.

Theo Henrar - born in 1958 in Amsterdam - studied Dutch law at Leiden University, specializing in business and commercial law.

After his studies Theo entered military service and was appointed as a reserve officer. He served as secretary to the Director of General Affairs of the Ministry of Defense in The Hague.

Theo's career began in 1987 at the predecessor of Tata Steel in IJmuiden, Koninklijke Hoogovens NV. He held various senior positions, both in sales and production and production planning as well as general management in the Netherlands and the United Kingdom.

After the merger between Hoogovens and British Steel to form Corus Group, Theo reorganized the European Market Unit and was Managing Director of forty steel service centers in the UK and continental Europe. Following his time in the UK, Theo briefly held the position of Managing Director of Corus Packaging Plus in 2007 with operations in the UK, Norway, Belgium and the Netherlands.

From 2008, Theo became Executive Chairman of Tata Steel Netherlands/Corus Netherlands and as Sales Director he was responsible for the distribution units in Continental Europe and the UK and for Tata Steel's Packaging and Building Systems sales sectors in Europe. He held this position until June 2020.
